Note Well

Early registration **MUST** be **postmarked** by **January 20, 2001** or **received** by **January 22, 2001**.

Late registration applies to all registrations **postmarked** after January 20, 2001 or **received** after January 22, 2001. Late registrations must be **received** by February 18, 2001.

On-site registration applies to all registrations **received** on or after February 19, 2001.
